

Roles & Responsibilities of Girl Board Participants

GIRL SCOUTS OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors is accountable for governing the affairs of the Council; for compliance with the charter requirements of GSUSA, for adhering to state corporate law; and for matters relating to federal government legislation affecting non-profit and non-stock organizations.

- Girl participants are non-voting members and serve one year terms. They are eligible to be reappointed.
- A minimum of 3 meetings are held each year. In-person participation is encouraged, but participation via teleconferencing is an option.
- Board meetings may be held throughout Northern California.
- Girl participants will attend a brief orientation session to review key documents and reports.
- Materials for Board meetings will be made available a week prior to each meeting. Girl members are expected to review the material in advance of each meeting.
- Girl participants are encouraged to actively participate in Board meeting discussions.
- Girl participants will be required to sign a confidentiality agreement. Members may be privy to information that is a work in progress or is of a confidential nature.
- As a Girl Scout, you have ideas that are important to share. The Board is interested in your views.
