Wish I Knew: What is that one thing you would like to have known before launching your first cookie business? Inspire your Girl Scout sisterhood by sharing tips and tricks you've learned along the way! Enter our *Wish I Knew* challenge by sharing a 60 second video on what made your business successful. Each video counts as a submission into the sweepstakes, so share as many tips in separate videos as you wish to be entered to win!

Sloth Advocacy: Shared all your pro tips? Now it's time for some animal conservation—sloths need our support! GSNorcal is partnering with the [Sloth Conservation Foundation](#) (SloCo) to provide girls the opportunity to support sloths during this year's Fall Take Action Program. Learn about the endangered pygmy three-toed sloths, perfect your *Save the Sloths* pitch, and share in a 60 second video to be entered into the sweepstakes. Each video counts as a submission into the sweepstakes, so share as much sloth love in separate videos to be entered to win!

Wish I Knew and Sloth Advocacy video submissions will be entered into a single sweepstakes to win a Go Pro HERO! Challenges open 12:01 AM PST on September 1, 2020 and end at 11:59 PM PST on September 27, 2020. Winner will be announced at our Virtual Fall Digital Day on October 3, 2020.

Challenge Rules

How to qualify:

- Entrants(s) must be a currently registered Girl Scout(s) with the Girl Scouts of Northern California (GSNorCal) Council to participate. Contest is for GSNorCal girl members only (not adult volunteers).
- Individual Girl Scouts, Girl Scout troops, or groups of Girl Scouts can enter. Girl Scouts of all levels are eligible.
- Entries can be submitted by an adult on behalf of a Girl Scout or group of Girl Scouts, but must be in the girl's own words.
- All minors who appear in the video must have a current appearance release on file with GSNorCal, or have their parents give permission for public use of their image. This will be indicated by a check box on the entrance form.

How to enter:

- Visit <https://www.gsnorcal.org/en/cookies/fall-program.html#challenges> and submit all necessary information via Wish I Knew Challenge and/or Sloth Advocacy entrance form between 12:01 AM PST on September 1, 2020 and end at 11:59 PM PST on September 27, 2020.
- Share a 60 second or less video of your Wish I Knew and/or Sloth Advocacy video submission via our online entrance form. You can either post your video publicly to

social media and then share the link in the entrance form or upload the video directly to the form. Accepted formats: Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, and TikTok video link, or .mov and .mp4 video files.

- Include a video, full names of participating Girl Scout(s), troop number, program level(s) of participating Girl Scout(s).
- If you upload to social media, include the tags @GSNorCal #Gsnorcalentrepreneurs. For Sloth Advocacy submissions, please include #slothconservation as well.

Girl Scouts of Northern California Sloth Advocacy and Wish I Knew Mentorship Video Challenge Sweepstakes Official Rules

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1. Contest Description

The Girl Scouts of Northern California Sweepstakes (Sloth Advocacy Video and Wish I Knew Mentorship Challenge), sponsored solely by Girl Scouts of Northern California (“Sponsor” or “GSNorCal”), allows an eligible individual (“Entrant”) to inspire girls to learn about and advocate for sloths and/or to support girl-to-girl mentorship by submitting their video submissions for

- Sloth advocacy, explaining why sloth conservation is important, why they love sloths, and why Girl Scouts advocate for sloths.
- Mentoring girls in entrepreneurship, by sharing what they wish they knew before starting the Fall and/or Cookie Programs in the past.

Winner will be randomly selected and announced at our Virtual Fall Digital Day on October 3, 2020.

2. Sweepstakes Period

Entries will be accepted beginning at 12:01AM PST on September 1, 2020 and ending at 11:59PM PST on September 27, 2020. All entries must be received by September 27, 2020 at 11:59PM PST.

3. Eligibility

The Sweepstakes is open only to registered Girl Scouts of Northern California girl members. Submissions may be submitted by an adult on behalf of a Girl Scout but must be in the girl's own words. You must provide all information requested in the entrance form. Each unique Sloth Advocacy and/or Wish I Knew Mentorship video counts as a submission into the sweepstakes. An entrant may submit multiple entries as long as each video entry is unique. Duplicate entries will disqualify an entrant. You may not enter more times than indicated by using multiple email addresses, identities, or devices in an attempt to circumvent the rules. If you use fraudulent methods or otherwise attempt to circumvent the rules, your submission may be removed from eligibility at the sole discretion of Girl Scouts of Northern California. Exception: The same person may submit multiple entries on behalf of other members (ex. A troop volunteer may submit entries of each of the girls in her troop), but each entry must be submitted separately.

4. How to Enter

Entrant must submit all required information via the Sloth Advocacy Challenge and/or the Wish I Knew Mentorship Challenge form at <https://www.gsnorcal.org/en/cookies/fall-program.html#challenges> by 11:59 PM PST on September 27, 2020. This includes a 60 second or less video of the Entrant's sloth advocacy and/or supporting girl-to-girl mentorship and encouragement, Entrant's troop number, Entrant's Girl Scout level, and Entrant's first names(s). Entrant may either post the video publicly to social media and then share the social post link in the entry form, or upload the video file directly to the form. Accepted formats: Instagram, Facebook, Twitter, YouTube, and TikTok video link; or .mov and .mp4 video files.

Except as otherwise provided herein with respect to the Submission, any other attempted form of online entry is void and will not be accepted. Submissions that in the Sponsor's sole discretion are deemed to be obscene, indecent, incomplete, or inappropriate may be disqualified and removed from the pool of eligible entries. Entrant, or anyone acting on behalf of Entrant, may not offer prizes, awards, gifts, money or consideration of any kind in exchange for votes in the Contest, and Sponsor reserves the right to disqualify any Entrant it believes, in Sponsor's sole discretion, to be engaging in such activity. Any use of automatic, programmed, or like methods of entry (e.g. bots or scripts) will void all Entrants' Submissions by such methods. By submitting an entry, Entrants (and, if minors, their parent or legal guardian) hereby agree to the terms and conditions set forth in these Official Contest Rules.

Submissions must be the original work of the Entrants, must not have won previous awards, must not have been published previously, must not infringe upon any third party's rights, and must be suitable for publication (i.e., not obscene or indecent).

Girl Scouts of Northern California reserves the right to share Submissions in future marketing and communications, including social media posts, website content, The Trailhead content, and other official communications. GSNorCal will credit the Entrant by name with each usage.

5. Prize - Go Pro HERO

The Sponsor reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value at its sole discretion. The Prizes are not transferable, assignable or redeemable for cash. The Prizes are limited to those specified above; all other unspecified costs, fees, and expenses associated with the Prizes' award, receipt, and use are solely the responsibility of the Prize Winners. Any and all federal, state and local taxes on the Prizes, if any, are the sole responsibility of the Prize Winners. Sponsor reserves in its sole discretion the right to suspend, withhold, modify or terminate any aspect of the Prizes at any time, should Sponsor determine that the Prize Winners or Prize Winners' parent or legal guardian's conduct violates the values of the Girl Scouts, the Girl Scout Promise or the Girl Scout Law.

6. Limitation of Liability

Indemnitees are not responsible for: (a) lost, late, damaged, destroyed, delayed, stolen, misdirected, incomplete, or illegible entries, or entries received through impermissible or illegitimate channels, all of which will be disqualified; (b) technical failures of any kind, including but not limited to the malfunctioning of any telephone, computer online systems, computer equipment, website, server provider, network, hardware, or software; (c) the unavailability or inaccessibility of any website or service; (d) unauthorized intervention in any part of the entry process or the Contest; or (e) printing, typographical, electronic, or human errors which may occur in the offer or administration of the Contest or the processing of entries. Entrant agrees that any and all claims, judgments, and awards shall be limited to actual out of pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering the Contest but in no event attorneys' fees or mediation related costs; and Entrant waives all rights to claim any punitive, incidental, consequential, and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses, and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased.
