

VOLUNTEER APPRECIATION IDEAS

Use our fun checklist for ways to thank leaders & volunteers in your service unit!

□ Show leaders some love at SU Meetings

- \Rightarrow Share a poem that shows volunteers their impact
- \Rightarrow Bring treats like coffee ("thanks a latte"), snacks, or something sweet
- \Rightarrow Ask Icebreaker questions that focus on leader appreciation and fun activities
- ⇒ Break out by levels and get leaders talking about what they love about being a leader, fun troop activities, or something about their troop that makes them proud
- ⇒ Have leaders divide into pairs and talk about exciting things they've done and accomplished this year, and then each person should come up with a creative award name for their partner and share out with the group
- ⇒ *Helpful Resources:* Appreciation Poems for SU Meetings, Appreciation Icebreaker Cards

□ Get girls involved in leader appreciation

- \Rightarrow Have cards out at a SU event that girls can create or personalize for their leaders. Have girls hand them out at the end of the event, or collect them to present to leaders at a SU meeting or celebration.
- \Rightarrow Invite girls to your awards celebration or SU meeting and have them hand out awards

□ Recognize a special leader(s) each month

- $\Rightarrow~$ Use our informal and customizable award certificates to recognize volunteers throughout the year
- ⇒ Thank a volunteer with a council fun patch at your leader meetings for something great she did that month (could include running a successful SU event, taking on a new role within the SU, leading a fun or creative troop activity that all her girls loved, etc.). □ Give them an award

- \Rightarrow Service Unit Awards can be given out any time of year choose from our list of awards or create your own unique awards
- \Rightarrow Nominate them for a National/Council Award any time before June 30th

□ Plan a celebration

- \Rightarrow Celebrate a special holiday (Valentine's Day, Leader's Day, etc.)
- \Rightarrow Host an awards ceremony (plan a luncheon, dinner, or dessert event or invite girls/troops to a SU meeting to help present awards)
- \Rightarrow Or celebrate just because!

□ Send a fun e-card
