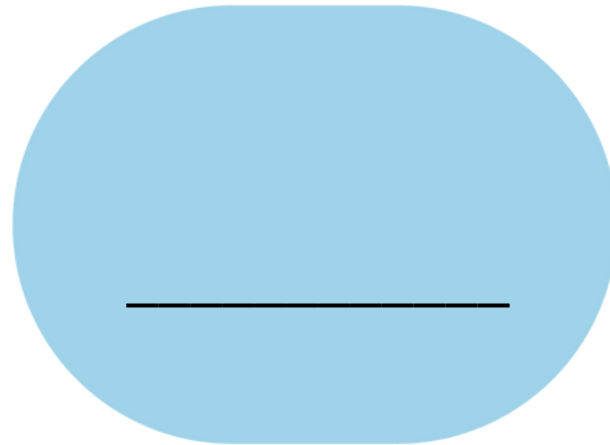
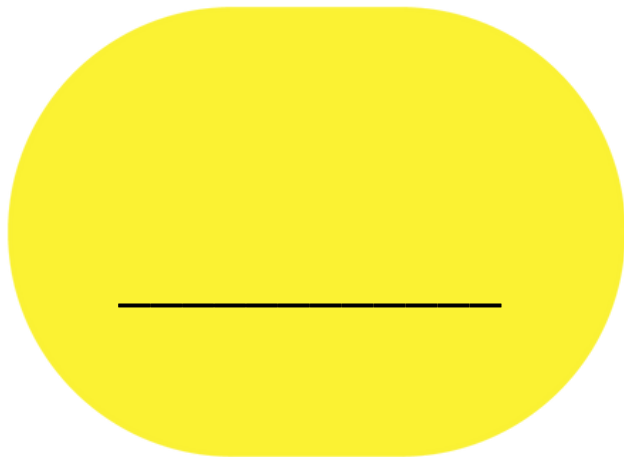
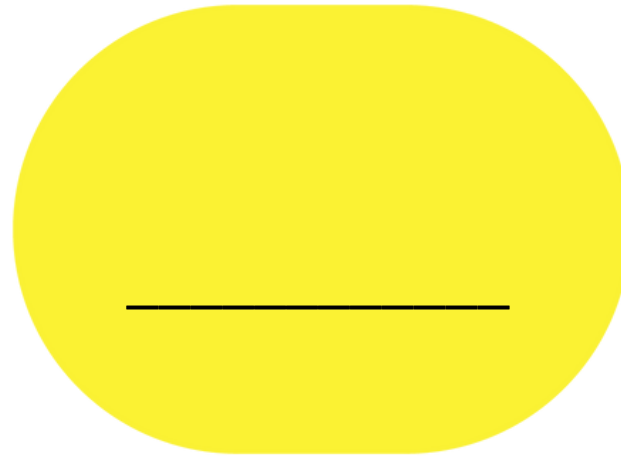
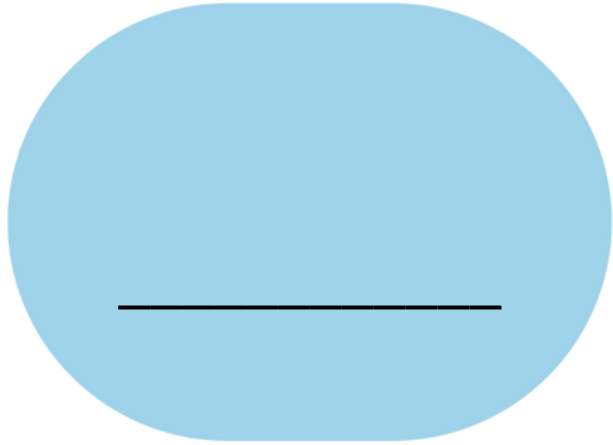
Show our volunteers you care!

- Make it your own! Add stickers/glitter/whatever you like!

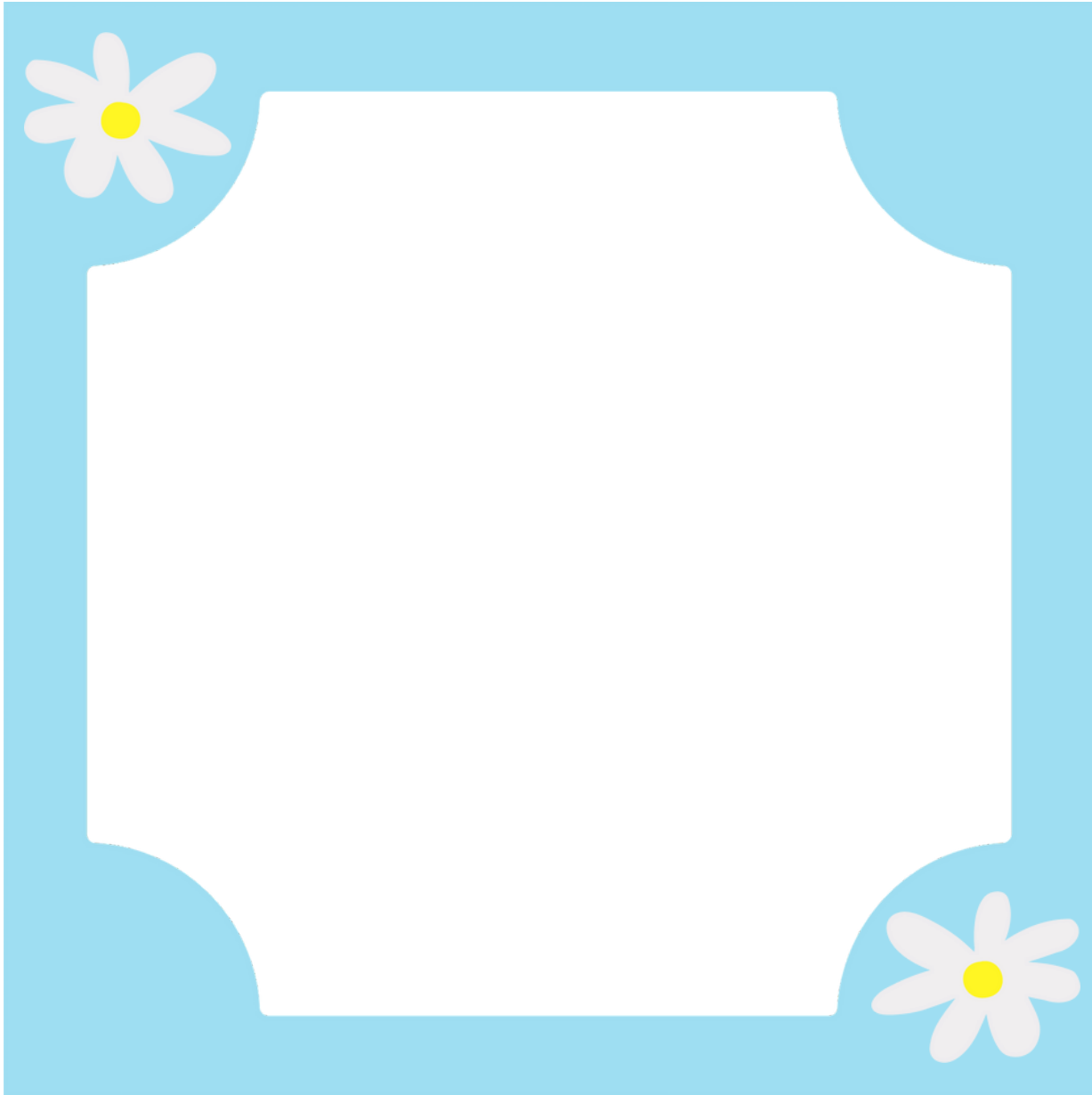
