Service Unit Delegate Election: January 4-24, 2022

BYLAWS OF GIRL SCOUTS OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA:

Each Service Unit shall be entitled to elect one or more Service Unit Delegates based on the total number of Girls registered in the Service Unit, as of September 30 of the year preceding the Annual Meeting.

The formula is noncumulative and is as follows:

- one (1) delegate for 1-49 girls;
- two (2) delegates for 50-499 girls;
- three (3) delegates for 500- 999 girls;
- four (4) delegates for 1000-1499 girls;
- five (5) delegates for 1500 or more girls.

In Service Units entitled to elect only one Service Unit Delegate, the Service Unit Delegate may be either an Eligible Girl or an Eligible Adult.

In Service Units entitled to elect two or three Service Unit Delegates, one and only one Service Unit Delegate shall be an Eligible Girl, except that in the event there are no Eligible Girls running, all positions may be filled by Eligible Adults.

In Service Units entitled to elect four or five Service Unit Delegates, two and only two shall be Eligible Girls, except that in the event no Eligible Girls or only one Eligible Girl is running, open position(s) may be filled by Eligible Adults.
