

Discover Together Program

Discover Together is a staff-led Girl Scout program for grades 2–5 that builds confidence, friendships, leadership skills, and a sense of belonging through hands-on activities, STEM learning, outdoor exploration, and Girl Scout traditions.

How does Discover Together work?

- 12 weekly sessions (8 sessions during summer programming)
- Weekly 60–90 minute meetings
- Badge-earning and hands-on learning activities
- Field trips and guest speakers as available
- Family engagement opportunities as available
- Closing celebration and recognition event
- Optional participation in the Girl Scout Cookie Program

What does the program include?

Discover Together is a staff-led program built around engaging Girl Scout badge experiences that help girls develop confidence, leadership skills, healthy relationships, and a sense of belonging. Through hands-on activities, STEM learning, outdoor exploration, and Girl Scout traditions, participants build life skills while having fun and connecting with their peers and community.



Curriculum themes

First Aid Friends: Learn basic safety and emergency preparedness skills while building confidence and helping others.

Creative Critters: Explore creativity and self-expression through hands-on art, nature, and animal-inspired activities.

Space Explorers: Discover the wonders of space through STEM activities, exploration, and problem-solving.

Gardening: Learn how plants grow while exploring nature, environmental stewardship, and healthy habits.

Sisterhood and Belonging: Build friendships, confidence, and a sense of belonging through teamwork, communication, and Girl Scout traditions.
