

Got Choices Program

Got Choices is a staff-led program for middle and high school youth that builds leadership, confidence, healthy relationships, and life skills through hands-on activities, small group discussions, guest speakers, and field trips.

How does Got Choices work?

- 8-week themed modules
- Weekly 60-minute small group sessions
- Badge-earning and life skills activities
- Guest speakers and role models
- Field trips and enrichment opportunities
- Opportunities for leadership and community building

What does the program include?

Got Choices is a year-round program made up of themed modules. Each 8-week Got Choices module consists of weekly, 60-minute small group sessions. Curriculum includes: **Community & Belonging**, **Health & Wellness**, **Secure the Bag (money management)**, **We're Not Really Strangers**, **Taste Buds**, and **First Aid**. Every module combines badge-earning and life skills activities. Guest speakers and role models share their expertise, and field trips serve as special events where participants can connect and build positive memories.



Curriculum modules

Community & Belonging: Build strong relationships, confidence, and a sense of belonging through Girl Scout traditions and leadership experiences.

Health & Wellness: Explore healthy habits, body image, social media, and positive decision-making.

Taste Buds: Discover cultural cuisines while building friendships and hosting experiences together.

We're Not Really Strangers: Develop self-awareness, reflection, and meaningful peer connections.

Outdoors: Connect with nature through outdoor exploration and environmental stewardship.

Secure the Bag: Build financial literacy skills through budgeting, saving, and smart money management.

First Aid: Learn basic emergency response skills while building confidence and leadership.
