Golden Gate Bridging - Member Booths

Golden Gate Bridging is Girl Scouts of Northern California's signature milestone celebration, bringing Girl Scouts together to cross the Golden Gate Bridge and celebrate their achievements. Member-hosted booths are a core part of the festival experience and play a vital role in showcasing the creativity, leadership, and sisterhood that make Girl Scouting so special.

About Member Booths

The festival area will feature member-hosted booths by GSNorCal troops, Service Units, committees, and alums. These booths must be related to Girl Scout programming (i.e., badge earning booth, fun Girl Scout activities, Destinations/Travel, etc.). We encourage booths to offer a simple, engaging, hands-on activity that can be completed in a short amount of time and is appropriate for high foot traffic and a wide range of ages (focusing on grades 5-12).

Booth Details

Each member booth includes one 10' x 10' booth space, one 6' table with two chairs, and two complimentary lunches (use coupon code GGBLUNCH at checkout). A limited number of generators may be available for booths with a demonstrated need, though power is not guaranteed, and all requests are subject to advance review and availability.

Important Guidelines (National Park Service & Presidio Trust)

Since the event takes place on National Park Service (NPS) managed land at Crissy Field, we are required to follow NPS and Presidio Trust guidelines:

- Branded pop-up tents are not allowed.
- Branded banners are allowed, but only if hung behind your table.
- Literature and display materials must follow the 70/30 rule — no more than 30% of materials may be promotional or advertising-focused.
- Food and inflatable items, such as balloons, are not permitted.
