Unique Awards

- **You Rock Award:** Award is an engraved or painted rock, given to volunteers that “rock” at their job
- **Gold Key:** Given for excellence in helping with troop paperwork, logistics, and money matters. Award can be a small gold key.
- **Angel Wings:** Honoring those who help troops succeed, recipients gifted small angel wings pin/charm.
- **Bracelet Charm:** Given to event committees, these charms are different each year and unique to each event.
- **Lawn Sign:** Create lawn signs and put them in front of volunteer’s homes for a fun Leader’s Day/End of the Year thank you idea. (ex: An Awesome Girl Scout Volunteer Lives Here!”)



Celebrations

- **Leader Appreciation Day:** Service Unit Team provides refreshments
- **Dinner:** Service Unit Team prepares or orders a meal for leaders/key troop volunteers in lieu of a service unit meeting to show appreciation.
- **Leader/Girl Scout Potluck:** Gather all the troop leaders and their Girl Scouts for a fun potluck. Bring some table games and encourage everyone to bring a craft or SWAP to share.
- **Bracelet Charm:** Given to event committees, these charms are different each year and unique to each event.
- **Wine Tasting or Happy Hour:** Have an ADULT ONLY event locally. Make sure to get council approval for events where alcohol is serviced.
