

Trip and Outdoor **Budget Planning Tool**

Use this Budget Planning Tool with the girls in your troop to help determine the budget for your trip or outdoor activities. Ask girls to brainstorm all the possible expenses to determine the total expenses of the trip. Once you know the total expenses, add up all your troop income to determine if you have enough money or if additional funding is needed.
