Each badge, there are five of them, includes ideas for how to tie their activities to their **Senior Sow What? National Leadership Journey.** It is much more fun when you see how their leadership adventure fits together.

The booklets are three-hole punched to fit nicely into their Senior Girls Guide to Girl Scouting.

How do the girls earn the badges?

Each badge has five steps to earn. Within those activities are three choices. If the girls are interested and they have the time they may do all of the activities. Not enough time? Then pick just one of the three. Each step includes tips for the leader. They also have many suggestions for the girls to choose within that step.

What about Community Service?

Do you have a group of Seniors who like including community service in their plans? Each badge also has suggestions for giving service.

Textile Designer:

When you see all the colors and textures of fabrics and yarns, do you dream up a million things to do with them? When Seniors earn this badge they will have learned the basics of textile art—and they'll have two fantastic projects to show for it.
